RCS's Abby Heried Recognized for Art Project



RCS 5th grader Abigail Heried received honorable mention for her art poster from the Christian Reformed World Missions Board.

Racine Christian School's Abigail Heried, 5th grade, won Honorable Mention for an art poster submitted to the Christian Reformed World Missions Board. Her artwork, entitled "Let's Go Fishing" was based on Mark 1:17: "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men." The theme was in keeping with worldwide missions work.

Abigail was one of 1032 students from across Canada and the United States to submit artwork to World Missions' popular annual poster contest. Christian Reformed World Missions has missionaries serving in more than 20 countries and, through partnerships, their work extends to more than 40 countries. CRWM and its missionaries are involved in a variety of tasks around the world, including evangelism and church planting, teacher and literacy training, plus community development and micro-enterprise internships.
